

## Centennial Committee Meeting

January 25, 2021

Zoom Meeting

The meeting was called to Order at 6:00 P.M.

Members Present were: Jerry Brant, Daryl Bodenschatz, William Cornell, Chris Cox, John Hawksworth, Ed Hudak, Paul Kundrod, James McCann, Eric Miller, Darrin Smith, and Nick Wuckovich.

There were no errors or corrections on the previous meeting so the minutes stand approved as read.

Chairman Wuckovich indicated that there was concern expressed by several committee members about the planned banquet for October 2021. Areas of concern were based on the current spread of Covid 19 virus as well as the ability to get sponsors and ads for the banquet book since many businesses were impacted financially by the Covid 19 virus. Discussion followed and it was the unanimous consensus of t of the committee members present to push the banquet back a year to October 2022. The Chairman reported that John Gromley sent a picture of the plaque that is being made for the fire school site that will have the past presidents and convention towns. He told the members that it was a beautiful wood finish and he will try to get the picture of the plaque out to the committee members for them to see.

It was brought up that our next project would be working on the plaques and pictures for the marching units at the convention. Chris Cox reported that he had spoken to the jeweler in Cresson about the plaques.

Jerry Brant reported to the committee that the Patton Fire Company is considering two options for the convention and that is either to push the convention back a month or to possible only have a one-day convention. He indicated the fire company will have their meeting on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of February to decide which option they will pursue.

Unfinished Business: Paul Kundrod ask if we heard anything more about the video that was done. The Chairman said he hadn't heard anything other than there was a date set to catch up with a couple of guys to finish the project but prior to the date when that was to occur, the session was cancelled due to the Covid-19.
